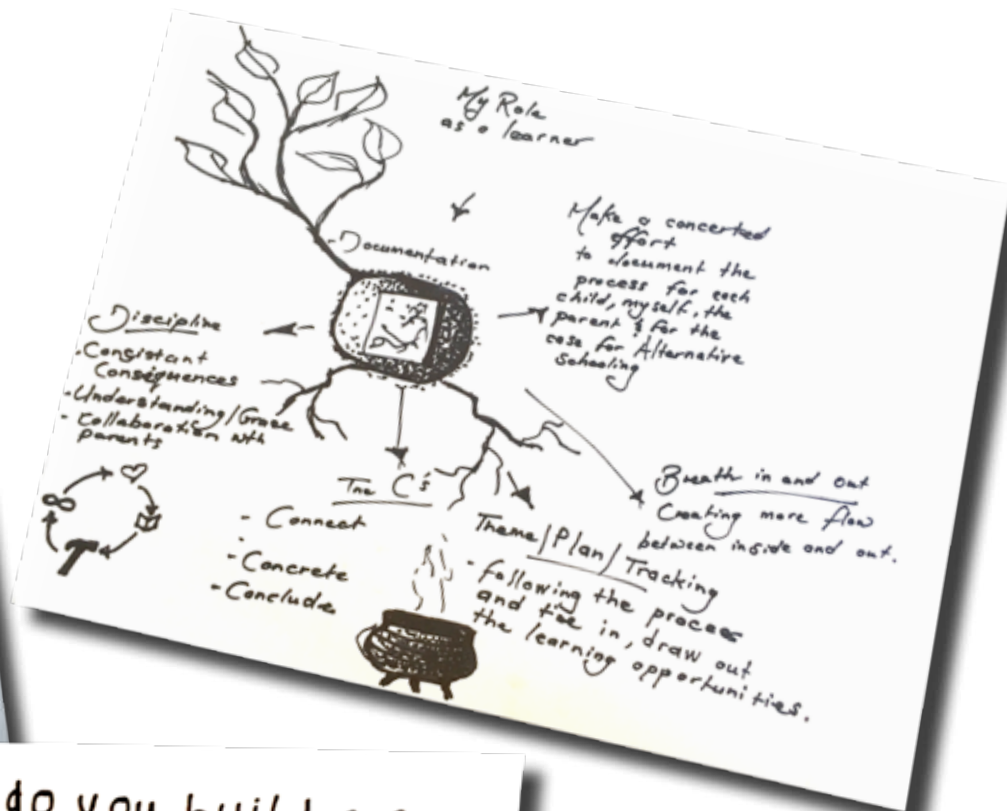
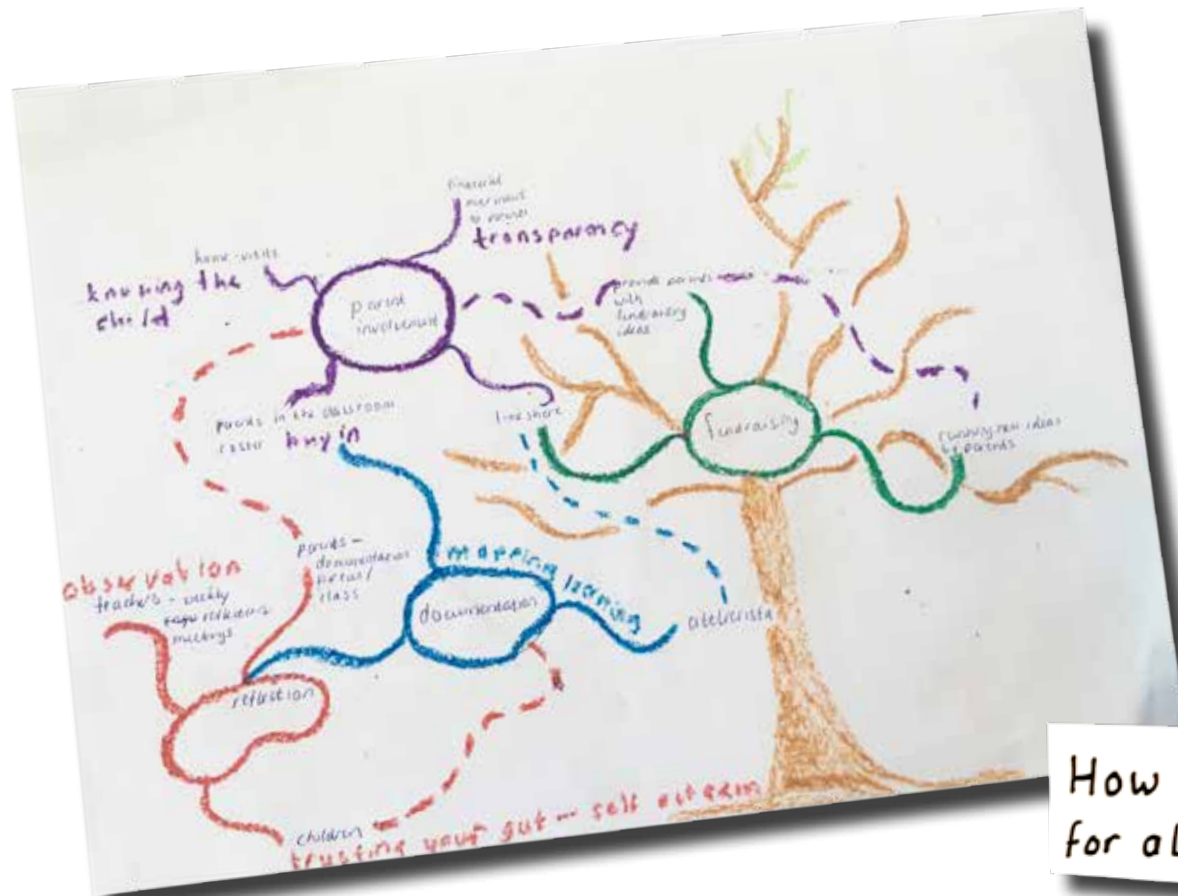
We spoke of

How do you involve parents meaningfully in mutual learning?

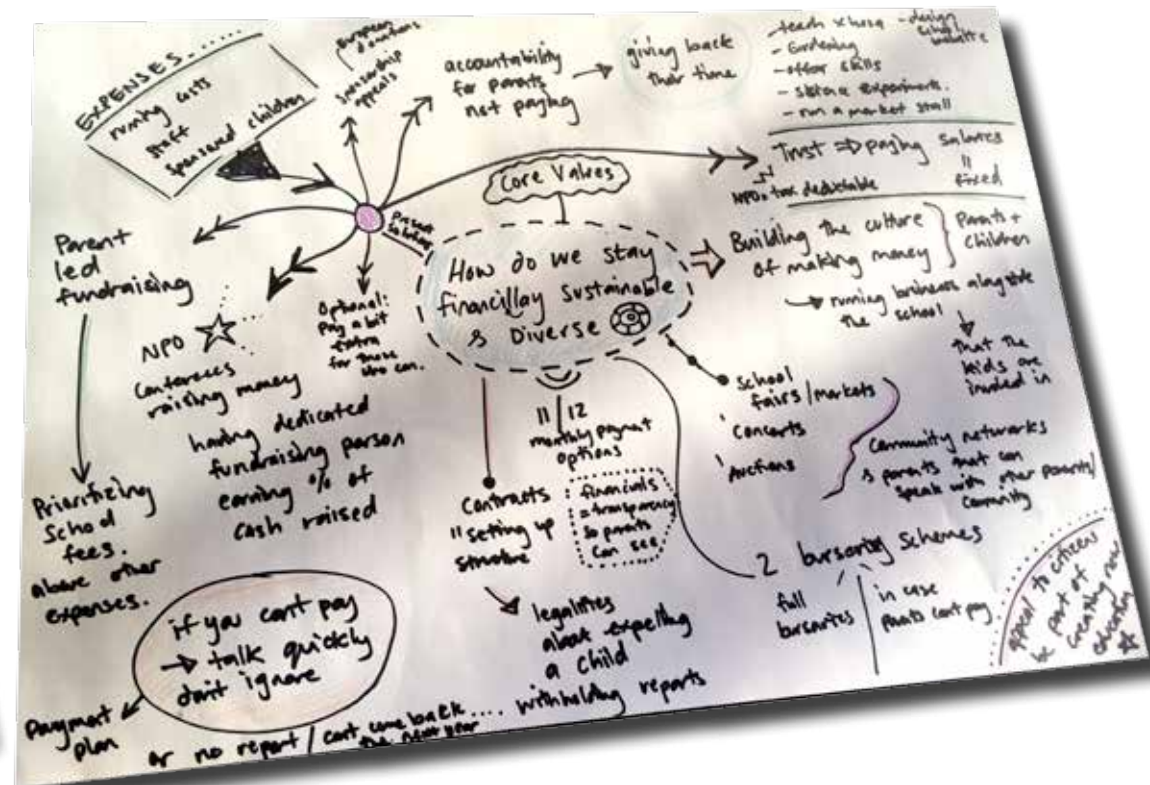
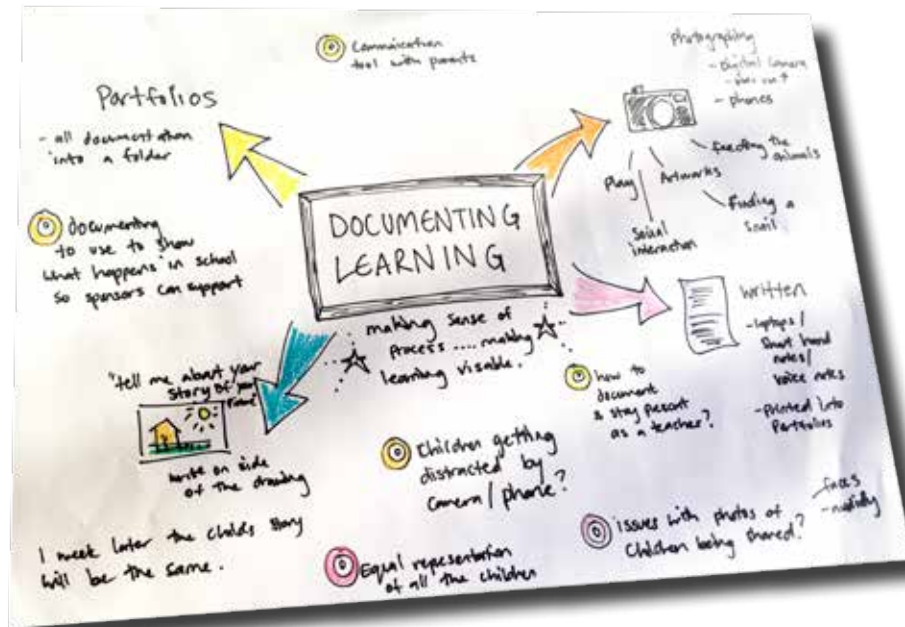


How do you build a case for alternative education?

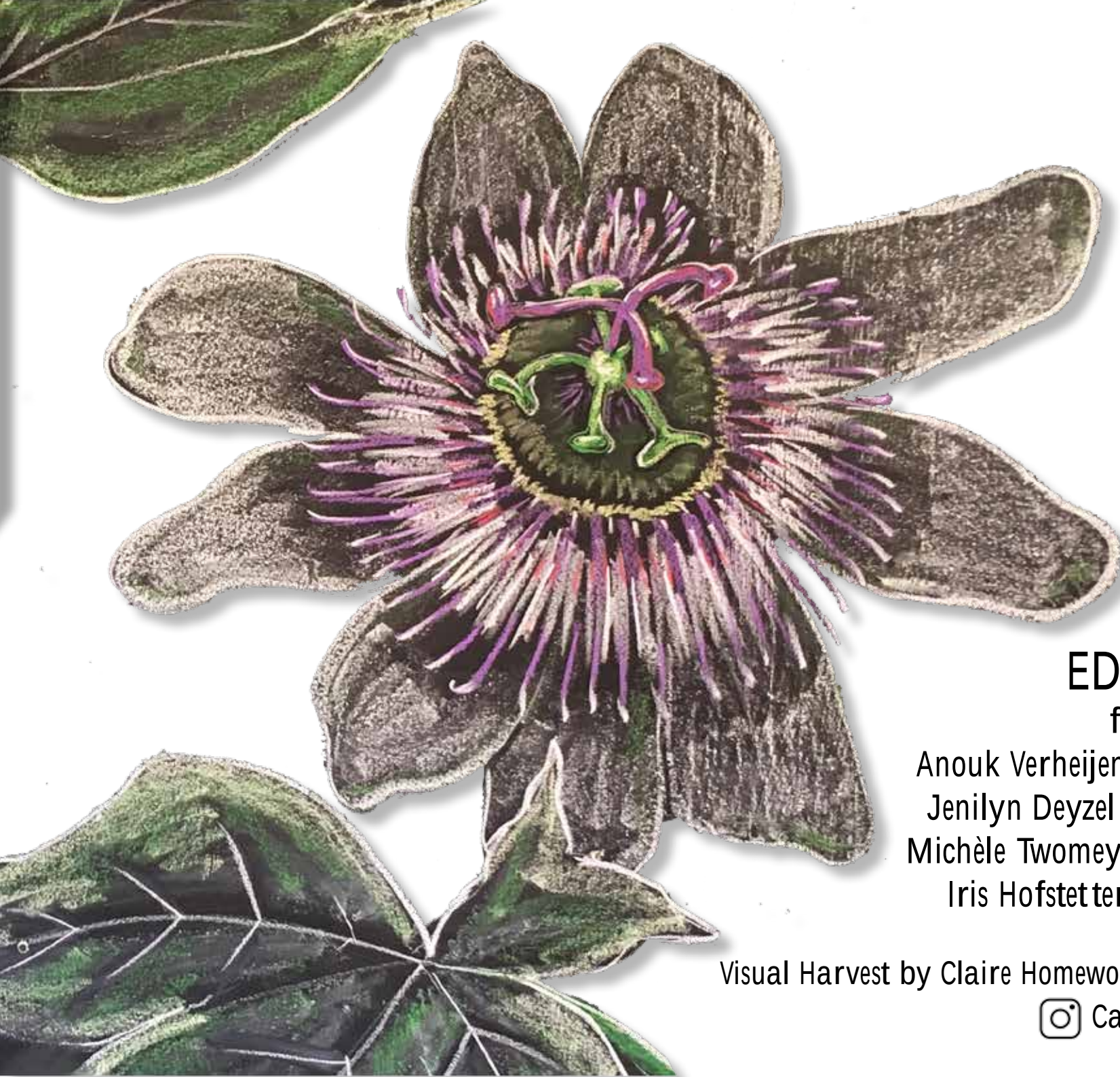
